To whom it may concern:

As per your request I inspected the pin oak tree at 16 Arbor Rd. This tree is in very good health. The root is lifting part of the driveway. The homeowner wants to replace the driveway but is concerned that there will be a problem. The tree is very close to the driveway. Cutting these roots this close to the trunk can cause problems for this tree in both stability and over-all health.

The options are removing the tree, creating a curve around the tree or using pavers instead of asphalt. If the pavers are uplifted, roots can be trimmed and the pavers re installed and leveled.

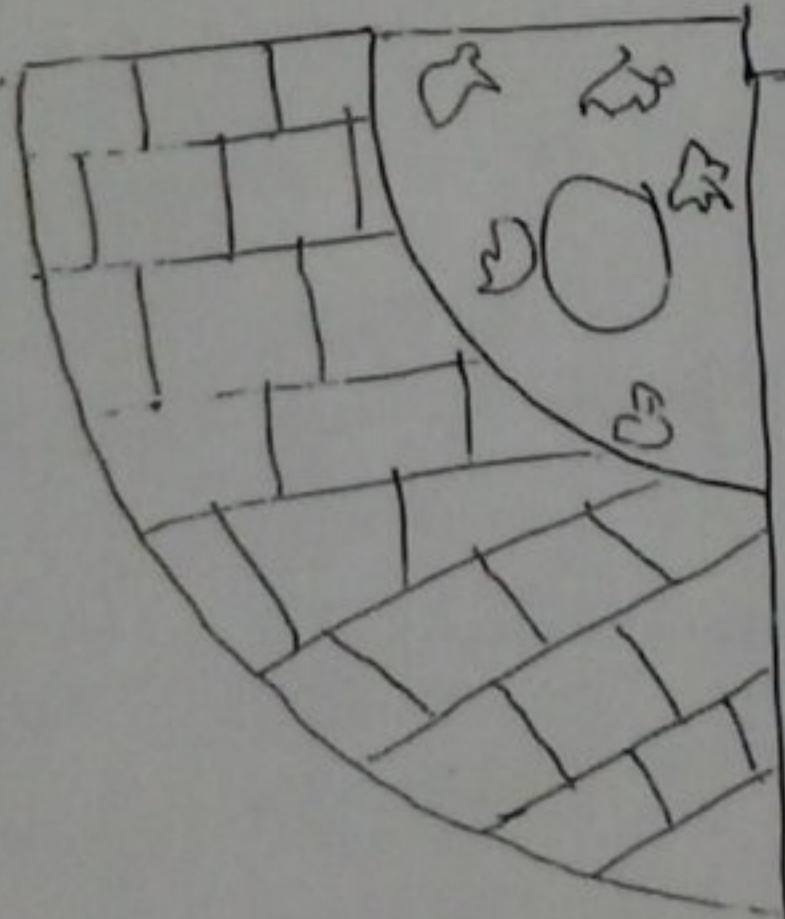
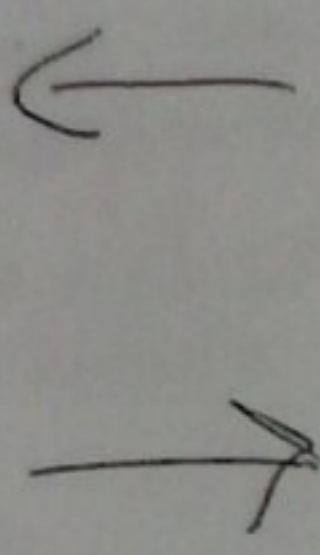
