Dear Village:

I was issued tree permits on July 16, 2015 and August 13, 2015 for removal of four Copper/European Beech trees on the front of my property. Upon inspection, three of the trees were observed to be dead and one was in an advanced state of decline. The permits were approved on condition of replacement of all four trees.

I have consulted with two landscapers regarding replacement of the trees. The area where the trees were removed is above the location of the cesspool for the house. The landscapers have stated that the location is unsuitable for replacement tress. Both stated that the removed trees did not survive due to the proximity of the cesspool.

Copies of the cesspool map and house survey are attached.

I do not have sufficient space on my property to place four large specimen trees as per the suggested tree list. I request that this matter be submitted at the next available meeting of the Architectural Review Board to determine whether replacement trees are required and if so the location, how many and what species of trees would be approved for replacement.


